Project Description	<p>The Murcia Mental Health Foundation was born with the aim of providing protection to people with mental illness in all its fields, as well as the defense, promotion and development of their rights; studying their situation and advising their families, joining their efforts to solve the problems that affect them all on the best way.</p> <p>The Murcia Mental Health Foundation CURAE MENTIS, carries out the development of Psychosocial Care programs for people with mental health problems within the Protected Homes resource, which works to reach higher levels of improve their quality of life and feel real integration within the community.</p> <p>Currently we have two Protected Homes, one located in the district of Alquerías with 12 places and another in the district of Santa Cruz with 13 places. The technical team develops its work from the resource located in</p>



	<p>Santa Cruz, where users meet during the mornings, from Monday to Friday, for the development of their occupational workshops.</p> <p>The fundamental objective in intervention with people suffering from a mental health problem should be the restoration of control of their life and their personal autonomy, through insertion into the environment where they operate.</p> <p>The important thing in the intervention is that these people have all the necessary information in relation to their problems, the protection established by the legislation and the different options available to them to achieve a standard life</p> <p>From our resources we carry out several work projects which are defined in two great variables of action:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Integral Accompaniment: Development of the autonomy and integration of people with Mental Health Problems in the community and their social resources, through assistance and professional accompaniment in their psychosocial rehabilitation process.</li><li>• Family intervention: Psychopedagogical program to support families and/or primary caregivers to improve their skills in managing the disease.</li></ul>
Tasks of the Erasmus intern	<p>Among its functions, the main ones will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Individual social attention to users.</li><li>• Coordination with the Social Work Units, Hospitals, Health Center and other social resources involved in the users.</li><li>• Management of financial aid.</li><li>• Planning / Supervision of leisure and free time.</li><li>• Participation and management in family meetings.</li><li>• Preparation of Social Stories and Reports.</li></ul>



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Management of all relevant documentation of the social area for the user.</li><li>• Support in the formulation and justification of Projects.</li><li>• Support in the organization of mental health awareness activities of the organization.</li></ul>
