Name of enterprise	At university of Murcia (UMU): Health, Physical Activity and Education Research Group (SAFE): The basic objective of the research group is to promote the study in the training of physical education teachers through physical activity and sport to achieve optimal learning and performance.
Duration	From 3 to 9 months
Working Hours	Around 30h/week
Project Description	The student will be involved in a project aiming at determining the effects in schools of an Action Plan for Health and Education (PASE) based on innovative proposals for physical activity and education in values that promote equality and an active lifestyle and generate healthy habits in students and their environment. For this purpose, an innovative hybrid and participatory methodology based on the Model of Personal and Social Responsibility (MRPS) and active breaks (DDAA) will be applied in the classroom.



Tasks of the Erasmus intern	The successful applicant will perform research on Physical Education and Schools, collecting and analysing data coming from questionnaires, accelerometers, observation methods, interviews, and others instruments and techniques.
Requirements	The applicant must have a fair background in Primary or Secondary Education and/or Physical Education. A good level of English or Spanish language and basic research skills are also required.
What do we offer	We offer immediate incorporation to an active project supported by national competitive funding. The student will benefit from large laboratory space, modern research facilities and from teamwork with high competent PhD students and post-doctoral researchers, under the close supervision and guidance from senior personnel and in a friendly, collaborative environment. She/he will acquire expertise in most basic Pedagogical Models and quantitative and qualitative research techniques, and others related to Physical Education and new pedagogical methodologies.
