Here you have a few good tips not to get lost in Murcia.

1. The University

The University of Murcia includes 4 different campuses but most of its facilities and buildings are spread over just two campuses : *Espinardo* and *La Merced*. (<http://www.um.es/universidad/planos/index.php>).

The oldest campus, *La Merced*, is located in the city centre. The larger campus is called *Espinardo*, and it is located just 5 km to the north of Murcia. The LAT bus number 39 will take you to the Campus of *Espinardo*. The price of a ticket is approximately 1 euro or you can buy a voucher for 33 trips that costs 15 euros. The tickets and the vouchers can be bought on the bus. The main bus stop is in front of the big department store *El Corte Inglés* and it will take you about 20 minutes to get to the campus. You can also buy the “UNIBONO” (<https://bonobus.um.es/>) that costs 20 euros for 30 days of unlimited travel within Murcia and the surrounding villages.

2. Accommodation

If you do not have accommodation yet, you can get information at the International Relations Office. *Vimur* is the accommodation service for International Students and will help you to find accommodation in rented flats, sharing with other students in the city. 3. Smart Card

Ask for your Smart Card now! It will make your university life easier! You will be identified within the University being able to get safe access to all types of information. It can be used in the library services, for access to computer rooms, to consult records, to enrol on elective courses, to pay fees using the electronic purse facility or to book sports facilities. 4. Sports

Sport is very important to the University of Murcia and it enjoys a great number of facilities such as sports halls, football and rugby pitches, aerobic and weight rooms, a gymnasium or an indoor swimming pool. These are mainly in *Espinardo* and are available for you to book them. (<http://www.um.es/deportes>)

5. University clubs and societies

The University favours the integration and participation of all those at University through the establishment of societies, such as the departmental organisations, the University “*tunas*”, co-operation for development, etc. *The Erasmus Student Network in Murcia* (ESN-Murcia) is a key society of students of the University of Murcia which helps international students to improve their integration within the Murcia society organising activities such as parties, tours or coffe. 6. Dining Facilities

You can find three canteens available in the Campus of *Espinardo* located in different buildings: *Centro Social Universitario*, *Apartamentos Campus* and Faculty of Economics and Business. You can also find other dining facilities around the city: *Colegio Mayor Azarbe* and *Las Oblatas*. There is also an extensive cafeteria service in the majority of university buildings. (<http://www.um.es/csa/comedores.htm>).

7. Supermarkets

There is a wide range of supermarkets all around the city from small grocery to big chains in the outskirts of the city. Those offering the best prices and a wide range of products are: *Mercadona*, *El Arbol*, *Dia*, *Carrefour*.

Those offering the finest items as well as a full range of branded products are *El Corte Inglés* and some other shops around the city.

8. Healthcare/Hospitals

You can go directly to a care provider with your European Health Insurance Card or equivalent paper form, if you need healthcare while on a temporary stay in another member state.

In Spain, in any case, Hospitals of the National Health System receive emergencies regardless the nationality or the health insurance of the patient.
